## **Brass / Copper / Chrome**

These metals are lightly lacquered to seal and prevent patinas. Gently remove dust with a duster or a clean, soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaning agents and commercial cleaning products.

## **Recycled Blown Glass**

Carefully wipe with a soft cloth dampened with warm water; alternatively, isopropyl alcohol can be used. Another option is to wash it carefully with warm or hot water in the sink with a small amount of cleaning solution.

## **Frosted Glass**

Clean frosted glass with warm water and mild detergent. Use a soft cloth to gently rub with smooth motions. Avoid abrasive products. Alternatively, wash carefully with warm or hot water in the sink with a small amount of cleaning solution.

## **Black Clay**

Use a duster or a dry cloth to remove dust.

## **PVC**

Use a duster, a soft white cloth, or a clean brush as needed. For tough stains, clean with a soft, absorbent white cloth using a solution of soap and warm water. Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth and dry with a clean white cloth. Ensure cleaning materials are free from dust and abrasive materials. Avoid using glass cleaners with ammonia or bleach; they can damage the plastic surface and cause discoloration.

## **Onyx**

Use a soft cloth, clean white cloth, or a soft brush as needed; do not clean with water.

## **Saman Wood**

Dust off with a slightly damp, soft, and lint-free cloth. Dry with a cloth in the direction of the wood grain. This is recommended to be done once a week.

Twice a year:

Apply a good-quality wood cleaner with a soft cloth. Do not use spray cleaners or polishes containing wax or abrasives, or oil-based polishes.

## **Cantera, Fiorito, Travertine and Recinto**

Use a duster or a clean, soft, white cloth to remove dust. Do not clean with a damp cloth.
