Studio davidpompa and Contramar reunite for Mexico City Art Week 2026 with Fragmentos de Mar, an exhibition that reflects on transformation, materiality, and the quiet dialogue between design and gastronomy.

Shells, as marine vestiges, embody both permanence and fragility. Geological archives that preserve the memory of the sea. Once a trace of life, they return now as a Bio Shell Composite: a shell-based material of ocean remnants, created from discarded fragments to form a new, intentional surface. Like terrazzo, it becomes a human made geology, a compression of time, memory, and celebration.

The exhibition unfolds through sculptural light and culinary interpretation, tracing the journey of matter from sea to table, from table to object, and from object to collective memory. Together, Studio davidpompa and Contramar weave a shared vision grounded in craft, renewal, and the enduring rhythm of nature.

The project is presented in collaboration with Dezeen, who will host the opening party, an evening that invites guests to immerse themselves in the sensorial encounter between light, flavor, and memory.
